She and Silva Screen Records now present the album Ten, a set of themes for solo piano that encapsulate her multifaceted career achievements during her time at the popular UK classical station.

Wiseman has carefully curated a selection of her live works for

Royal occasions, her compositions for Wolf Hall sequel The Mirror and the Light and her longstanding collaborations with Stephen Fry and Alan Titchmarsh, among others. A resonant sense of Englishness reson-



ates throughout: the spirit of Vaughan Williams and Elgar pervades the album, an approach that has also informed Wiseman's acclaimed film scores such as Wilde.

Highlights include the pensive 'Man of Sorrows' theme from

Wolf Hall, and the regal phrasing of Elizabeth Remembered, which commemorates the late Queen. Alleluia (O Clap Your Hands) is a more celebratory piece for the coronation of King Charles III.

The melancholic phrasing of The Falling Leaves of Autumn is superbly evocative, as is the deeply poignant, Covid-composed Together, which Classic FM listeners were invited to interpret in their own fashion. The best is saved until last: the VE Day 80 anthem A Day May Come with a powerfully sonorous choral performance from VOCES8.

Ten epitomises why Wiseman is held in such high regard: her penchant for gorgeous chromatic expressiveness and a firm dedication to sumptuous melody makes her one of the UK'S finest contemporary composers.
